Date: Sunday 7th April


Morning session is aimed at beginners, dogs should have a desire to retrieve (doesn't need to be polished) and have some basic obedience skills (doesn't need to be perfect) including walking on a loose lead, recall, sit and stay for a short duration.

Afternoon Session is aimed at more advanced dogs. Dogs should be capable of undertaking marked, memory and blind retrieves, have good general obedience, directional control (outs and backs) and a good stop whistle.

The exact criteria covered in each session will depend a little on the dogs in the groups but we plan to cover a range of marked, and memory retrieves, along with handling exercises. We will have access to a small lake so will have the opportunity to retrieve from water and handle around water as appropriate for each level.

Your hosts for the training weekend are Claire and John Denyer of Family Dog Services. Claire and John are full time trainers and behaviourists with a particular passion for working dogs. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times unless otherwise instructed. This event is suitable for dogs of all ages and abilities, the only restriction is no dogs with aggression towards dogs or people

Any faeces should be cleaned up immediately and taken away for disposal.

Bitches in season should not attend as this is a group event

All instruction and training methods to be followed by the owner/handler

Clients can be asked to leave at any stage if they are unable or unwilling to follow our instruction or advice and we believe that this results in causing a danger to other persons or animals.

You should ensure that you have appropriate insurance in place before attending, most pet insurance policies will include 3rd party liability








