Judges (change of Panel Judge): Miss Terri Siwek [A3772] & Mr Martyn Bell [NP]

- Timing:** Meet at 9.30 a.m. for a 10.00 a.m. start
- Definitions:** Stakes may be limited to 16 dogs
- PUPPY:** For dogs or bitches aged under 18 months on the date of the Test
- NOVICE:** Any dog or bitch not to have been placed 1st in a Novice Test, nor 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Test, nor to have been given any Field Trial Award including a CoM
- OPEN:** Open to any dog or bitch
- Dummies will be supplied by the Lagotto Romagnolo Club of Great Britain
- Awards:** Certificates for 1st-3rd places and for Best Hunter in each class.
COMs may also be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
Trophies for 1st place in each class: **The Hebe Trophy** – Puppy, **The Ruby Trophy** – Novice, **The Sekhi Trophy** – Open. **The LRCGB Trophy** for Best Hunter.
The Raghill Cup will be awarded to the highest scoring Lagotto Romagnolo on the day.
The Iteru Trophy will be awarded to the Judges' Choice Lagotto Romagnolo.
- Entry Fees & Entries:** **£10.00 per dog per Test for LRCGB members / £15.00 per dog per Test for non-members.**
Entries to be received by e-mail no later than Monday, 5th May 2025, together with payment via BACS (details on Entry Form). The draw will take place at the Working Sub-Committee Chair's home on Tuesday, 6th May). Confirmation of entry, together with exact location details, will be sent to all entrants the following day.
- Location:** Deerbridge is located on the northern side of the B3001 Elstead Road near its junction with Milford Road and Shackleford Road, and between Elstead village and the A3. WhatThreeWords for the entrance off the road is ///vesting.essay.natural. Directions to the exact location will be sent with confirmations, and LRCGB signs will be out on the day.
